

TREE PLANTED FOR RICHMONDIN ISRAEL

A tree has been planted in the Paul Harris Forest, on the hills of Galilee, in the name of Richmond Rotary Club, and the Club president Mr Brian Frith, has received a certificate stating that the tree has registered No 1440 in the Forest Book held in the custody of the Kishon Rotary Club.

The forest, commemorating the founder of the Rotary movement, is near the town of Safad, and the chairman of the International Committee of the Kishon Club, in a letter to Mr Frith, states that it is their desire to further relations between Rotarians in their District and Rotarians in Richmond, and invites any members who might visit Israel to be the guests of the Kishon Club, which covers four industrial towns with a total population of 150,000.
